Loan Programs

The following are loan programs of the City of Aurora Development Services Division:

Revolving Loan Fund

A Small Business Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) is available to existing businesses within Aurora's city limits, with particular emphasis on aging commercial corridors, including Colfax, Havana and Montview. Priority will be given to businesses that meet criteria based on the redevelopment goals of the city.

Colfax Economic Enrichment Program

CEEP was created to complement and leverage existing funding initiatives in the Original Aurora East End Arts District by contributing to the sustainability of core business ventures. Funded activities must comply with CDBG eligibility criteria and contribute to the improvement of the neighborhood.

Arts District Loan Fund

The City of Aurora seeks to attract artists, art-related businesses and developers of art-related space to Original Aurora in order to enhance the East End Arts District and contribute to the revitalization of the City's original downtown.
