



City of Aurora Energy Efficiency & Renewable Energy **Rebates**

Residential Energy Efficiency and Conservation Rebate

The city will rebate up to \$1,000 for Aurora homeowners who make energy efficiency and conservation upgrades to their homes. Upgrades include insulation, weather stripping, and high efficiency furnaces and air conditioners. The city is layering these rebates on existing Xcel Energy rebates.

Main Street Commercial Energy Efficiency & Conservation Rebate

The city will rebate up to \$1,500 for Aurora business owners who make energy efficiency and conservation upgrades to their buildings. The city is layering these rebates on existing Xcel Energy rebates.

Solar Permit Fee & Energy Audit Rebate

This program rebates an energy audit and the solar permit fees required for solar installations. The audit must include a blower door test and must be conducted by Xcel Energy; audit costs will be rebated. Initial permit fees plus one subsequent plan review fee (if needed) will be rebated.

Solar Hot Water Heat Rebate

In partnership with the Governor's Energy Office, the city is offering a rebate for solar hot water heating systems. Residential property owners can receive up to \$3,000 and commercial property owners can receive up to \$15,000 depending on the size and cost of the system. Debt Finance Fund

Soon to be offered through a partnership with the Governor's Energy Office, this program will provide small, low-interest loans for residents and business owners who wish to install solar systems on their buildings. Stay tuned for details.

Rebates are available to Aurora property owners who make **energy efficiency** improvements or install **solar electric** or **solar hot water** heating systems.

All rebates are available through April 2011 or until funds are exhausted.
